How To Use This Pack

This is a long trail designed to use the main senses to explore the Zoo



I am the same height as a ______ bear.




I can run my tongue over my teeth and feel their shape.



This is home to the wallabies, llamas, alpacas, sheep and goats!



There are also fish tanks. A tall one upstairs and a long one downstairs.


The long tank has benches in front of it. I can sit down here and watch the fish.

Inside Elephant Kingdom you will find the Discovery Den. This is number on my map.


It might be dark in here with some colorful lights.










Aardvark Burrow

How many aardvarks are sleeping?


Aardvarks smell different to me. I can smell what the aardvark's smell like by putting my nose to the holes.

The Nature Area






On the other side of the lake, behind the Tigers, is the nature area. Down in the Nature Area are streams, ponds and lots of plants. This is number on my map.
