

1 1/2 HOUR RAINFOREST ANIMAL ROUTE

From the entrance, turn right at the silver giraffe then head towards the red brick building. Turn right around the building before going across the decking to reach the 'World Apart' walkthrough to see sloths, reptiles, small monkeys and more. Turn left at the exit of the walkthrough and walk down the slope past more monkeys before going through the sealion tunnel to reach the orangutans. After this, retrace your path through sealions to rejoin the main route. Follow along next to the road to see more monkeys, tropical birds, and the sun bears. After bears, go left up the slope around the spider monkeys and through the tunnel to reach an anteaters, lemurs, otters and binturongs. Go up the steep hill by anteaters past the red pandas. At the top of this hill are gibbons. Cross the main path at the gibbons to reach the exit on the far side.

2 HOUR ENDANGERED ANIMAL ROUTE

From the entrance, go around the large play area to the top of the steep hill. Go up the small ramp on your right to view A the sun bears, before returning to the steep hill and going down it next to the Amur leopards. Turn right at the spider monkeys, then almost immediately turn left onto the main path. Walk past smaller endangered monkeys before turning at meerkats and reaching the gelada baboons. Turn down the slope towards B otters. Continue past the lake, through the food court, before turning up the hill, past the play area, towards the paddocks C Elephants are on the right of the path, and the mixed African paddock (including white rhino) is on the left. Loop around the mixed paddock to visit the endangered vultures before entering D the giraffe house with pygmy hippos. Go through the giraffe house and retrace your path to the edge of the lakes. Turn right and go across the lakes and up the small path to E Amur tigers, and Visayan warty pigs and spotted deer. After these animals, retrace your steps slightly to rejoin the main path going up the long, gentle slope on your right to reach F Komodo dragons.

2 1/2 HOUR AFRICAN ANIMAL ROUTE

From the entrance, go past the large play area to the chimpanzee enclosure. Walk through this enclosure, and on the far side, cross the main path and walk down the slope next to red pandas. At the bottom of the slope, go through the small door on your left. This will take you past lemurs and across the bridge towards gelada baboons. At geladas, turn right towards meerkats and the lion. Go to the inside lion viewing to see the fennec foxes. After foxes, go past the food outlet before turning up the slope at koi fish then turning down the 'Elephant Bush Walk' around the outside of the elephant paddock. At the end of the elephant paddock, turn right (towards the play area) to reach the 'Edge of Africa' area. This area includes hyenas, mandrills, cranes, small antelope, and cheetahs. After cheetahs follow the path towards the mixed African paddock, including rhino, giraffe, antelopes, zebra, and ostrich. Walk around the paddock towards vultures before entering the giraffe house with pygmy hippo, rock python, weaver birds, and other small African species. After the giraffe house, for the quickest route to the exit, walk past the front of the elephant house before rejoining your original
